FORWARD IN FAITH

What does it mean to be a thinking Catholic in the contemporary world? Beginning in January, the Archdiocese of San Francisco is launching a program designed to answer that very question.

Forward in Faith is a 20-week program that will be offered in twelve parishes, beginning on the week of January 17, 2012. The initial "semester" will run from January through the week of March 20, 2012, and the second "semester" will take place next fall from the week of September 6th through November 6th.

The program has been developed by an Archdiocesan task force under the supervision of Bishop McElroy. It is designed to reach large numbers of adult Catholics in the pews with a wide-ranging, high quality exploration of our Catholic faith.

The Archdiocese was able to forge a partnership with Boston College, which has access to many of the finest theologians and catechists in the country. Boston College has made available their online library of presentations, from which the Archdiocese has constructed its curriculum.

The course will be offered in twelve parish locations spread throughout the Archdiocese on different weekday evenings from 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm. The format involves the viewing of an online presentation, followed by reflections upon those presentations in small group sessions.

The Archdiocesan task force is also initiating a pilot program for young adults that will offer the same courses online with facilitated online dialogue groups led by staff members of Boston College. This pilot program is limited to 200 students. If you are interested, please contact Sr. Maureen or one of the priests.

Forward In Faith can be used to fulfill the requirements for catechist formation and certification. To encourage our catechists to participate in the program, St. Teresa's will pay the tuition costs and fees of our catechists who enroll. We also want to encourage other adult members of the community to take advantage of this educational opportunity, and we will try to make funds available for any adult who would like to participate as well.
